The Alaska Health Insurance Premium Payment Program

The Alaska Health Insurance Premium Payment Program is sponsored by Alaska's Department of Health and Social Services. It helps Medicaid or Denali KidCare recipients and their families by reimbursing the cost of monthly premiums paid for group health insurance coverage and maximize state savings.

To prequalify for the HIPP program, an applicant must be eligible for either Medicaid or Denali KidCare within the state of Alaska and must have access to group health insurance that is offered by a job or COBRA. Individuals may apply for HIPP at any time of the year, even outside of the employer's open enrollment period.
